## Call for Scores for Young Composers (Age 13 - 21 years)

This is a unique opportunity for voung composers from Aberdeen and Aberdeenshire to hear their music performed by one of Scotland's leading string quartets, The Alba Quartet.

Five shortlisted composers will participate in a workshop under the guidance of leading international composer Judith Weir, and hear performances of their music at an evening concert.

Young composers are invited to submit new works of between 5 to 10 minutes duration for string quartet (2 Violins, Viola & Cello).

Five works will be selected from the initial 'call for scores'. These young composers will be invited to take part in a workshop with the highly acclaimed Alba Quartet, under the guidance of leading International Composer Judith Weir. The workshop day will culminate in a performance of the pieces at an evening concert, and the winning piece will be performed again at the Aberdeen International Youth Festival 2009.

AIYF Compose! is open to young musicians between the ages of 13 and 21 living or studying in Aberdeen City or Shire.

Closing date for applications is 5pm on Monday 1 September 2008.

The University of Aberdeen Music Prize and Aberdeen International Youth Festival in association with sound will be hosting a competition for young composers in October 2008.
