A course for young composers and creative musicians aged 14 – 19

# **What is Go Compose?**

Go Compose! is a 3-day composition course for young composers aged 14-19 who are still in full-time education. You will work with professional composers and musicians to create your own original piece of music which will be performed by Red Note ensemble at the end of the course. You will also receive a recording of your piece.

# Who will lead Go Compose?

The project will be led by **sound**'s composer in residence, John De Simone, and Eleanor Alberga, leading contemporary composers in the UK.

Eleanor and John will be joined by professional musicians from Red Note Ensemble who play orchestral instruments (violin, flute and cello) and are very creative and open about the kinds of music they play!

### Who is it for?

Go Compose! is for anyone aged 14 – 19 who has tried composing and who would like to learn more. We are looking for people with potential and commitment who are enthusiastic about creating their own, original music and keen to try out new ideas.

#### When is it?

Go Compose takes place between Sunday 15 and Tuesday 17 October 2017. It is a challenge to compose a piece in three days so we expect you to commit to the whole project.

#### What does it cost?

Go Compose! costs £55, this includes £45 for the course and two evening meals on Sunday and Tuesday which we will provide for you. You will also need additional spending money for lunches.

You can invite family and friends to attend the final performance. Tickets for this event cost £5

## **Residential option**
