What is Go Compose?

Go Compose! is a 3-day composition course for young composers aged 14-19 who are still in full-time education. Who is it for?

Go Compose! is for anyone aged 14-19 who has tried composing and who would like to learn more. We are looking for people with potential and commitment who are enthusiastic about creating their own, original music and keen to try out new ideas.

Go Compose takes place between Sunday 14 and Tuesday 16 October 2018. It is a challenge to compose a piece in three days so we expect you to commit to the whole project.
