A one-day practical workshop for instrumental and vocal teachers

What will I learn on this workshop?

This practical one-day workshop examines the basic principles of improvisation through a range of musical styles and genres. You will learn how improvisation can be used as a valuable teaching tool and the benefits it can bring to your pupils. In addition you will:

- discover practical ideas and methods for introducing improvisation into your lessons
- explore avenues for composition and extemporisation through improvisation
- discuss ideas for developing a holistic approach to your teaching
- share ideas with like-minded teachers

Participants should bring their instruments so they can take part in the practical elements of the workshop. Pianists will have access to keyboards.

How much does it cost?
