- Any instrument (sorry no voices!) capable of playing at least one and a half octaves of a chromatic scale allowed.
- No age limit. Participants must be at least Grade 5 standard and have good sight reading skills.
- The score will be sent to participants beforehand to practice
- Audience welcome for workshop, but particularly for performance!
