For young composers and creative musicians aged 14 – 19

What is Go Compose?

Go Compose! is an intensive composition course for young composers aged 14-19 who are still in full time education. It's a unique opportunity to work with professional composers and musicians to create your own, original piece of music which will be performed by Red Note Ensemble on 14 October at Woodend Barn. You will also receive a recording of your piece.

Who is leading Go Compose?

The project will be lead by leading contemporary composers Pippa Murphy and Gareth Williams. Pippa and Gareth will be joined by professional musicians from Red Note Ensemble who play orchestral instruments and are very creative and open about the kinds of music they play!

Who is it for?

Go Compose! is for anyone aged 14-19 who has tried composing and who would like to learn more. We are looking for people with potential and commitment, who are enthusiastic about creating their own, original music and keen to try out new ideas.

When is it?

Go Compose! takes place between 12 and 14 October 2014. It will be a challenge to complete a whole composition in three days, so we expect you to commit to the whole project.

How to apply

To apply, please complete the application form overleaf and post back to us or visit www.sound-scotland.co.uk/sound_events-go-compose-2014 where you will be able to download an application form which can then be e-mailed or posted to us.

What does it cost?

Go Compose! costs £45 for the whole course. We will provide drinks in breaks but not lunch. We may be able to waive the fee for anyone for whom this is too expensive – you are welcome to contact us to discuss this. In addition, you will be able to attend the performance of participants pieces free of charge. Anyone coming with you will be asked to pay £5 for their ticket.

Residential option

We will be able to organise supervised accommodation for you if you will be travelling from a distance and would like the option to stay overnight to attend the course. There will be an additional cost for this. Please contact us directly for more information about this.

What happens after I've submitted my application?

We will confirm your place on this course by 29 September. You will then be asked to confirm attendance, and for the fee of £45.
